**Graduation is an important formal celebration of the accomplishments you and your classmates have made during your time in the Winterset Schools. As such, we expect students to treat it as that and respect the ceremony and the people involved. Students are required to wear proper attire (semi-formal clothing) to participate in the graduation ceremony (young men should wear dress pants, dress shirts with a collar, dress shoes, and socks. Young ladies should wear a dress, skirt, or dress pants and blouse, and proper shoes). If any student needs help acquiring these items, please contact the school office by the first week in May. We will expect you to return home to change on graduation day if you do not meet our expectations.

***Graduation gowns and caps are not to be altered. Students who do this will be asked to return the cap and gown to its original state prior to the ceremony and before the student participates.

****Caps and gowns are to be worn at commencement only. Please do not wear gowns to and from church or school. Gowns may be pressed, but please be sure to check the instructions before pressing. USE ONLY A WARM IRON, OTHERWISE THE GOWN WILL BE RUINED!
